West Hawaii Water Safety Instruction is a private entity, and offers Lifeguard Training according to guidelines set by the American Red Cross. This class focus is on Life Saving and Skill Training in preparation for any emergency situation that may arise in the Aquatics Environment or within the community.

Elements of Personal Safety, Rescue and Personal Growth are incorporated into Lifeguard Training. Some of the time in training is spent watching videos, while other time is spent in the water practicing skills. The CPR / AED portion of the Lifeguard Training is completed on the pool deck and the Instructor will provide the scenario and observe as the participants perform the necessary steps to provide life-saving measures. This simulation is meant as a learning opportunity for all.

This Training is to prepare for life-saving. We are all here for success, and the Instructor will help guide us. All are expected to watch and learn for positive feedback.

Class Sizes

The minimum number to run a Lifeguard Training course is three participants.

Payment / Deposit / Cancellation

Registration will be taken by phone or in-person.
